- Built a parallelized audio-ingestion and speech-to-text pipeline on Databricks (Python, SQL) using Azure AI model endpoints, for integration into production workflows at Peru's largest microfinance bank
- Designed LLM-based interpretation of transcribed speech, orchestrating multiple Azure AI models to extract meaning from recorded audio
- Coordinated the AI team's project planning while automating routine engineering tasks with LLM-assisted tooling

- Evaluated robustness of 1B–8B Llama 3 models to hardware bit-flip faults: built a gradient-guided attack framework and contributed evaluation code to the lab's fault-injection harness (PyTorch, Hugging Face), run at scale on an A100 Slurm HPC cluster
- Designed a draft-model-gated decoding defense and early-warning detection metrics against targeted bit-flip attacks, as first author (research in progress)
- Benchmarked 7 fault-tolerance defense methods against 2 classes of adversarial bit-flip attacks (stealth and damage) on GSM8K, with DROP and TriviaQA sweeps in progress
- Co-authored manuscript on cross-scale model resilience, a speculative-decoding-based fault detection and correction defense; contributed mitigation implementations and trade-off analysis
